



## Key Stage 2 Results Academic Year 2014 - 15

Staff and students have been working incredibly hard to perform well in the school's national end of year examinations. I am delighted to announce that the results were exceptionally good with all students performing above teacher expectations and indeed above national results.

In effect in all but reading all of our students entered for KS2 SATs achieved above the national expectation for their age, indeed some were only 1 or 2 marks from a Level 6.
