

ACS Uniform Policy for Early Years Foundation Stage

At present pupils in Early Years Foundation Stage are not required to buy uniform from the school uniform shop (except for PE uniform for Reception pupils). Therefore parents with children in Nursery or Reception are free to purchase their child's uniform from a uniform shop of their choice. Please follow the guidelines below when purchasing your child's uniform.

Nursery

Girls & Boys	<p>Plain white T-shirt (full or half sleeved depending on parental choice and weather)</p> <p>Plain dark blue, black or gray jumper or cardigan</p> <p>Plain dark blue, black or gray jogging trousers</p> <p>Black shoes with velcro fastenings- not with laces please. Alternatively Plain white, black, blue or gray trainers (with velcro tops) can be worn as long as they are water proof.</p> <p>Please note: No sandals and boots. (If your child walks to school and needs to wear boots in a rainy or snowy day, please ensure to bring their school shoes in a bag and change them into their school shoes on arrival to school).</p> <p>All Nursery parents need to provide the school with a spare set of clothes, including underpants and socks, for their child to in a named bag to be kept in school, in case of the need for their child to be changed during the school day. If and when these spare clothes are used, they need to be sent back to school the next day or as soon as possible.</p>

Reception

Girls	<p>White shirt or blouse</p> <p>Dark blue, black or gray pinafore dress or box pleat skirt</p> <p>Dark blue, black or gray cardigan</p> <p>Gray, black or dark blue elasticated trousers or leggings</p> <p>Black shoes with velcro or buckled fastenings-</p> <p>Please note: No sandals, boots or trainers</p>
Boys	<p>White shirt (full or half sleeved depending on weather)</p> <p>Gray, black or dark blue jumper</p> <p>Gray, black or dark blue elasticated trousers</p> <p>Black school shoes with velcro fastenings-</p> <p>Please note: No sandals, boots or trainers (If your child walks to school and needs to wear boots in a rainy or snowy day, please ensure to bring their school shoes in a bag and change them into their school shoes on arrival to school).</p>
PE Uniform (for girls and boys)	<p>We prefer that parents buy the blue PE jumper and jog trousers available from our school uniform shop.</p> <p>Please note: Our PE trousers come with cord fastening. We request parents to take the cord out and replace it with elastic because reception pupils are too young to tie and untie the cord. (Elastic is widely available from supermarkets). Children need to wear a plain white T-shirt under their PE jumper, so if they become too hot during the activity they are able to take their jumper off.</p> <p>PE shoes: Plimsolls with velcro or elasticated tops (not with laces please) in a named PE bag to be kept in the classroom. No trainers please.</p> <p>On the PE day specified by the class teacher, pupils are expected to come to school dressed in their PE uniform. They will still come in their normal school shoes and will change into their plimsolls just before their PE lesson, and will change back to their normal school shoes at the end of lesson. If parents want to, they can send their child in trainers on the day of the PE lesson provided the trainers are not either black or white, and have Velcro fastenings (not laces).</p>
