

Our Learning

Islamic Studies: This term in Islamic Studies we will be learning about Good Character (Akhlaaq). This will consist of topics such as Being trustworthy, Seeking permission before entering, Removing harm from the road and Being good to our neighbours. We will also learn Duas from our Duaa book and Sorahs with translation.

Literacy: This term in Literacy we will 'Persuasive posters using slogans' The class will look at a number of different types of advertising and discuss how they persuade people to buy products, how to make a catchy slogan. Finally they will choose their own product and plan and carry out an advertising campaign .

The children will also learn about '*Newspaper report and Narrative text* i.e. Myths and legend stories with dilemma. The class will read several reports and stories which give points of view about different subject. Eventually they will write their own newspaper report and their own story with mythical creature and enchanted object.

Numeracy: In Numeracy we will learn to write 4 and 5 digit numbers in words and figures and to know their place value. They will also learn to count in multiples of 6,7,9. 25and 1000. This term we will focus on 7, 8 and 9 multiplication tables. Children will also learn how to count backward and forward with negative and positive whole numbers. They will also be learning to round any number to the nearest 10,100 Or 1000.

PSHE: Children will be learning about *Bullying*. They will learn how to deal with it? , how would bullying hurt your feeling?, how to stop bullying? Children will be given different scenario and will be taught how to deal if you are in that situation.

Humanities: Children will be learning about *The Roman Empire* and it's effect on Britain.

In Geography, children will be learning about *Sea and Ocean of the world* and also be learning about different countries and their locations

Science: This summer term children will learn about '*living things and their habitat* 'and . They will learn that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways. They will also be learning about classification keys between and food chain. Children will also be learning about *Teeth, and The digestive system* in living things.

Art: Children will be exploring & making their own '*mosaics*' *Roman food and their design*.

PE: Children will be playing outdoor adventure and competitive games.

ICT: Children will be using software to design '*programs*'

D&T: Children will be designing and making models of Submarine.
